

BOLD GOALS:

- To advance Alpha Xi Delta's philanthropic goals and efforts.
- To cultivate strategic national philanthropic programming and initiatives.

OUTLINE OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Guide the Philanthropy Territory Directors and Alumnae Engagement Specialist(s) who will assist chapters, alumnae associations, and the general membership in philanthropic engagement.
- Develop and implement programs to advance Alpha Xi Delta's philanthropy strategic priorities.
- Benchmark with other NPC, IFC, and NPHC organizations to ensure competitive advantage.
- Maintain frequent and open communication with Philanthropy Territory Directors and Alumnae Engagement Specialist(s), delegating requests for assistance when applicable, and following up on reports and correspondence. Recommend strategies where needed.
- Provide ongoing training to the National Philanthropy Team about current practices and successful initiatives.
- Obtain and maintain materials and files on successful philanthropic efforts.
- Help research and apply for appropriate corporate, Alpha Xi Delta Foundation, and other funding opportunities to support the philanthropic focus and/or partnership.
- Provide new ideas and motivation to support chapters and associations who are struggling with their philanthropic focus.
- Review philanthropy service reports submitted by chapters and associations.
- Research and identify service needs of Alpha Xi Delta members and create programs to improve their philanthropy efforts.
- Assist the National Awards Committee in determining National Philanthropy Service Award winners.
- Serve as the leader of the Philanthropy Think Tank and act as a sounding board for philanthropy ideas and planning.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Approximately 10 – 15 hours per month.
- Travel to college chapters as needed and approved.
- Attend training and educational opportunities provided by the Fraternity.
