

BOLD GOALS:

- Work to ensure that our members have a broad understanding of Alpha Xi Delta Ritual and encourage them to incorporate its teachings in their lives.
- Exemplify the Ritual of Alpha Xi Delta to our members.

OUTLINE OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Know the appropriate manner in which the Fraternity's ceremonies should be performed and the equipment required for those ceremonies.
- Create, plan, and facilitate programs, trainings, and accompanying materials for college chapters, alumnae associations, and national meetings. National meetings include but are not limited to: Officer Academy, Summer Programming, National Convention, and Founders' Day. These programs and materials should be related to the Fraternity's Ritual (philosophy, ceremonies, equipment, best practices, etc.) and the Fraternity's heritage.
- Assist in the planning and coordination for the Installation of new chapters. Attend Installation and facilitate the Installation Ceremony.
- Plan, coordinate, and facilitate the Initiation Ceremony at National Convention.
- Review the Fraternity's ceremonies each biennium and make recommendations for revisions as necessary.
- Plan and implement Ritual training for the Educational Leadership Consultants and Leadership Coaches.
- Provide support and consultation to chapters.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Approximately 5 hours per month.
- Travel to college chapters as needed and approved.
- Attend training and educational opportunities provided by the Fraternity.
